Dear Parents of Sixth Grade Students,

The time is quickly approaching for our sixth grade promotion celebration. The "big event" will be held Wednesday, June 5, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. in the courtyard of the school. This is a special time for our sixth graders and their families, and indeed, for all of us. Our goal is to provide a promotion experience that is **fun, meaningful, and appropriate** for elementary school.

Clear standards for apparel have been established for the promotion ceremony. We do not want parents to feel they have to spend a lot of money for this event, and chances are that many students already have appropriate clothes at home right now. We ask that the sixth graders dress in what is considered appropriate for church or Sunday school. **Strapless dresses, mini skirts, formal dresses, and high heels for girls are not allowed.** "Sunday Dress" includes spring or summer type dresses, skirts/blouses, or nice slacks. Appropriate shoes would be flats or a very low heel. **Make-up of any kind, such as lipstick, is not allowed.** Appropriate clothing for boys would be a dress shirt and slacks, tie optional, and a clean pair of shoes. **"Inappropriate" dress for boys would include tuxedos, shorts, "baggies" or sagging pants, or t-shirts.** We appreciate your support for these guidelines that we believe are appropriate for a sixth grade promotion. If you have any concerns over the outfit picked out by your child, have them bring it to school and show their teacher as this will help avoid any embarrassment on the day of promotion.

**Sixth graders may leave with their families after the promotion ceremony. Siblings will be released from their classrooms to attend the ceremony, so please save a seat for everyone in your group. If you want any of your sixth graders' siblings to attend the promotion ceremony you must fill out the bottom portion and return to school by Friday, May 31, 2019.**

**PARKING:** Parking will be at a premium on the day of Promotion. There will be parking on the street, in the south lot, and on the blacktop which you may access via the bus circle driveway. Please be aware that it may be necessary for you to park your car some distance from school and walk.
